In other words, the time during which the user is talking on the phone, sending text messages or navigating on the internet using the data service. The opposite of payable minutes, or minutes gratis, which refers to the best game for winning money, is a game for winning money that the user can use the service without being charged, generally as part of a promotion or a data plan, unlimited. Some phone plans or services offer unlimited minutes, which means that the user can talk on the phone as much as they want without worrying about the best game for winning money or accumulating additional costs. In the context of internet services, payable minutes generally refer to the use of data service to browse the web, watch videos or use applications that consume data. Some data plans offer a limited amount of data per month, and the user is charged when the limit is exceeded. In other cases, the user can be charged for each megabyte or gigabyte consumed, depending on the chosen plan. In summary, payable minutes refer to the time of active use of a telecommunications service, or data service, during which the user is being charged, while the best game for winning money contrasts with gratis minutes or unlimited, during which the user can use the service without being charged.
