This tends to make Japanese goods and services cheaper for foreign buyers, while imports become more expensive for Japan.</p><div><h4>Reasons Behind a Weak Yen</h4></div><p>The value of the yen is influenced by several elements, such as interest rates, inflation, and economic growth. At present, the yen is weak due to the Bank of Japan maintaining a loose monetary policy, unlike most main economies that are tightening theirs. This gap in interest rates has led to the yen&#39;s devaluation.</p><div><h4>Effects of a Weak Yen</h4></div><p>A weak yen has both positive and negative implications. On the one hand, it reduces the cost of Japanese goods, possibly increasing sales and profits for Japanese firms and benefiting big Japanese multinational enterprises. However, an increased cost of imports results in more expensive products and services for Japanese consumers, as well as for businesses, adversely affecting the household sector and contributing to inflationary pressures.
